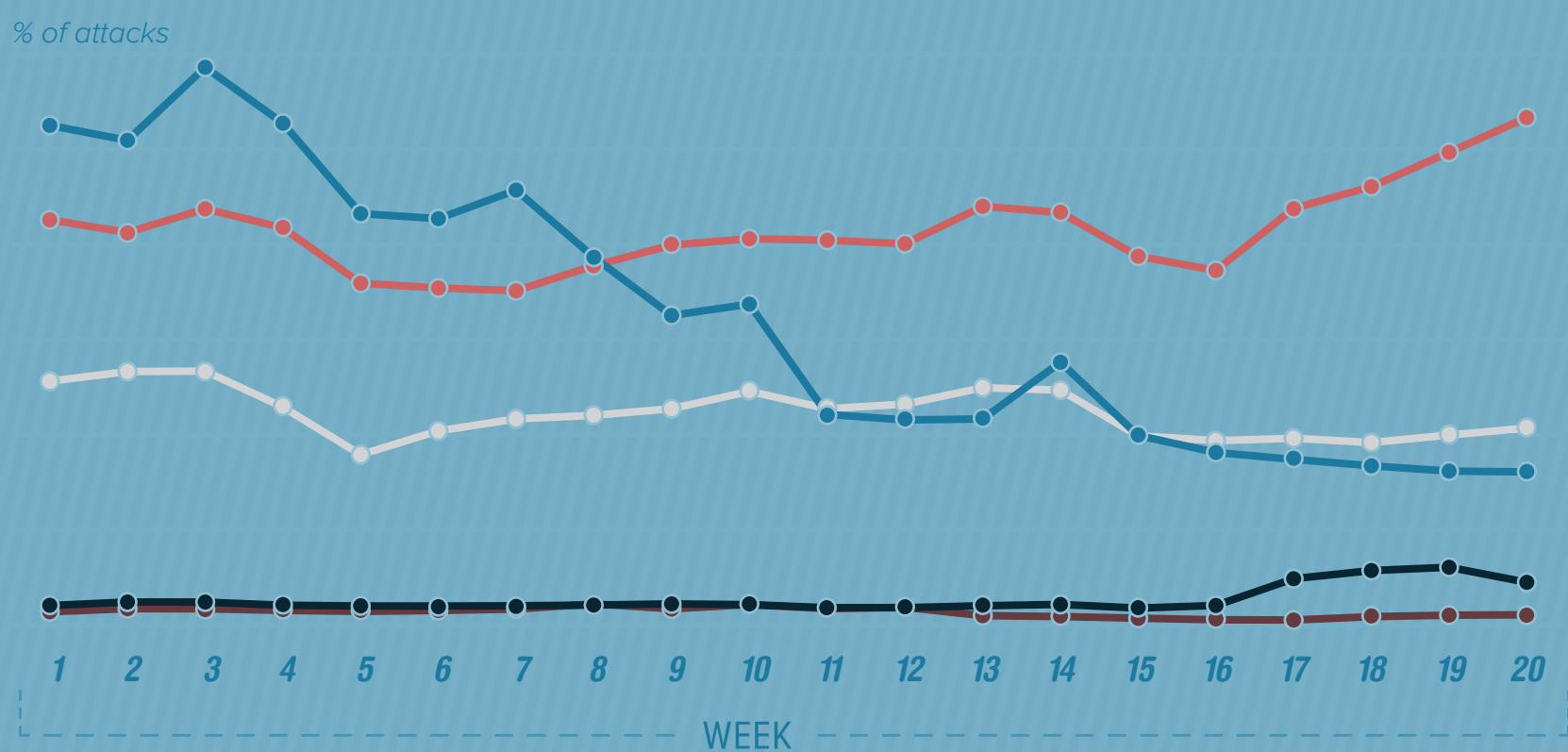


Indusface Vulnerability Report 2014

XSS attacks gradually decreased after touching the peak in the 3rd week.

The vulnerabilities 'Exploitable Exception Handling' and 'Sensitive Information Leakage', have been setting a dangerous trend with the data depicting almost an uniform trend of being close to the peaks in all sectors.

Source code disclosure vulnerability slowly crept up, and spiked alarmingly in week 18 and 19, giving enough reasons and warnings for Coders to be more cautious in the recent future.

An interesting trend was observed in SQL Injection attacks, with a major spike in the 8th week immediately after a steady increasing pattern was observed from week 3 to week 7. Week 10 was observed to witness similar spike.
